

During The 2022 Election Cycle, Major Corporations That Commemorated AAPI Heritage Month Gave Over \$1.1 Million To Lawmakers Who Blocked Federal Voting Protections That Would Help The Communities These Companies Claim To Celebrate

SUMMARY: During the 2022 election cycle, major corporations that have publicly touted their celebrations of AAPI communities and claim to support voting rights contributed over **\$1.1 million** to Senate Republicans who blocked two pieces of federal voting rights legislation, the [Freedom to Vote Act](#) (FTVA) and the [John Lewis Voting Rights Advancement Act](#) (JLVRAA). The legislation would have helped combat voter suppression efforts that are used to target marginalized communities, making federal voting rights protections essential for AAPI communities.

Chairwoman of the Congressional Asian Pacific American Caucus Judy Chu has laid out how voter suppression efforts harm AAPI voters, particularly after the “surge in AAPI turnout was significant enough to be the margin of difference in a number of swing states” in the 2020 election.

Several companies that claim to support for voting rights have donated over **\$1.1 million** in the 2022 election cycle to the Senate Republicans who vehemently oppose the expansion of access to the ballot:

- **Verizon** commemorated AAPI communities in 2021 but has donated **\$190,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Amazon** commemorated AAPI communities in 2021 but has donated **\$152,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Citigroup** commemorated AAPI Heritage Month 2022 but has donated **\$53,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Walgreens Boot Alliance** commemorated AAPI communities in 2021 but has donated **\$27,500** to Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Walmart** commemorated AAPI Heritage Month 2022 but has donated **\$196,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Microsoft Corporation** commemorated AAPI Heritage Month 2022 but has donated **\$208,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Intel Corporation** commemorated AAPI Heritage Month 2022 but has donated **\$57,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Google** commemorated AAPI Heritage Month 2022 but has donated **\$170,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.
- **Boston Scientific** has commemorated AAPI communities but has donated **\$30,500** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.

- **Cisco** commemorated AAPI communities in 2021 but has donated **\$20,000** to Senate Republicans in the 2022 election cycle.

Corporate hypocrisy is on display yet again as these companies publicly commemorate AAPI Heritage Month and make platitudes supporting voting rights while they bolster the coffers of the politicians currently blocking voting reform legislation from passing.

In 2021, Senate Republicans Blocked Two Federal Voting Rights Bills That Would Have Protected Marginalized Communities' Access To The Vote And Restored The Voting Rights Act While Allowing For Restrictive State Voting Bills That Disproportionately Affect Women And Communities Of Color.

As The AAPI Population Has Grown Drastically In The U.S. Over The Past Two Decades, So Has Its Voting Block, As Seen By Its 47 Percent Increase In Turnout During The 2020 Presidential Election.
