

House Oversight Republican Opponents Of ESG Get Over \$4M From Big Oil On Top Of Millions In Oil And Gas Assets

SUMMARY: Republicans on the House Oversight committee rail against environmental social governance (ESG) considerations for businesses and banks.

Unsurprisingly, throughout their careers, these same members took in over **\$4 million** from the oil and gas industry. Attorneys general leading the anti-ESG charge, Alabama's Steve Marshall and Utah's Sean Reyes, have brought in **\$32,500** and **\$11,000**, respectively, from oil and gas companies.

In addition to Big Oil sending money straight to their campaign coffers, six House Oversight Republicans hold between **\$3.3 million and \$22 million** in oil and gas assets. This includes:

- **Virginia Foxx (R-NC)** sits on \$405,007-\$960,000 in oil and gas assets in companies like Exxon, not including her gains from rampant oil and gas stock trading of the last two years.
- **Pat Fallon (R-TX)** has \$99,008-\$310 in oil and gas assets, in part through funds like Vanguard Energy ETF that almost entirely consist of oil and gas investments.
- **Kelly Armstrong (R-ND)** has \$2.7 million-\$10.3 million in assets through oil and gas wells throughout North Dakota.
